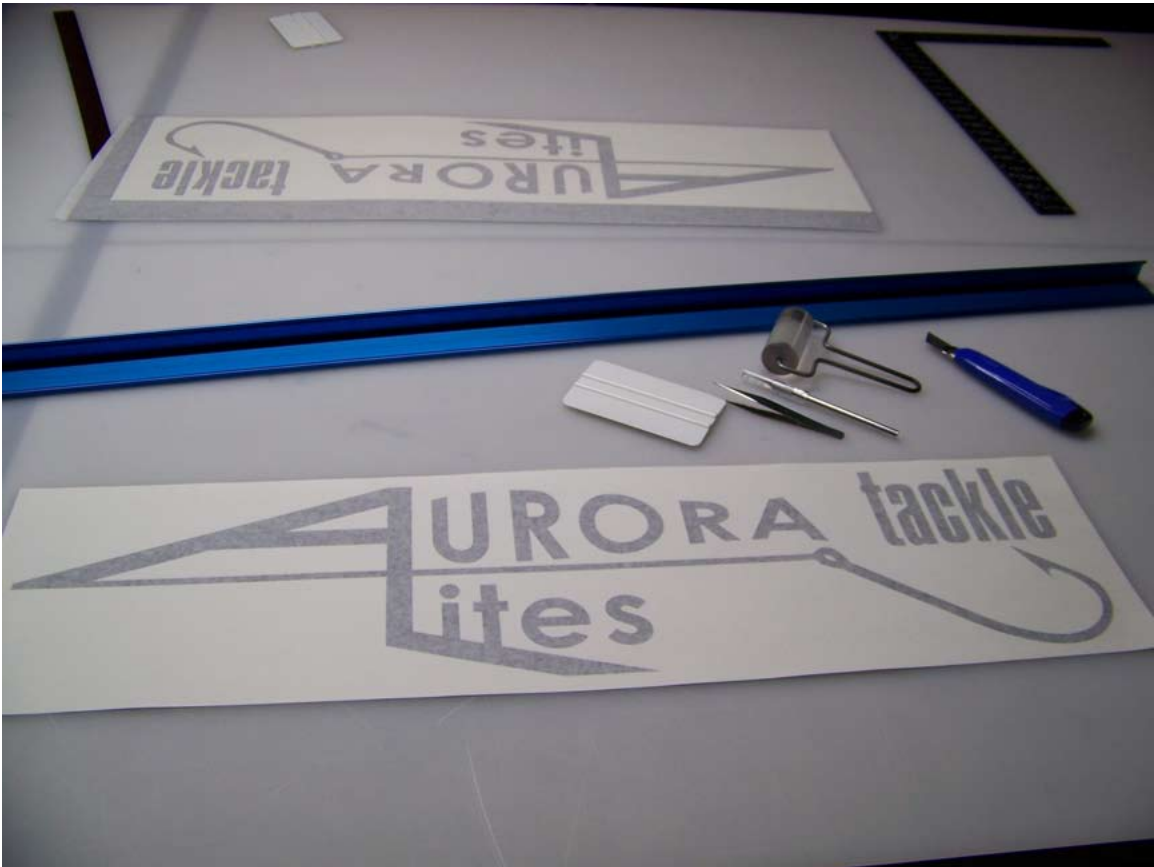
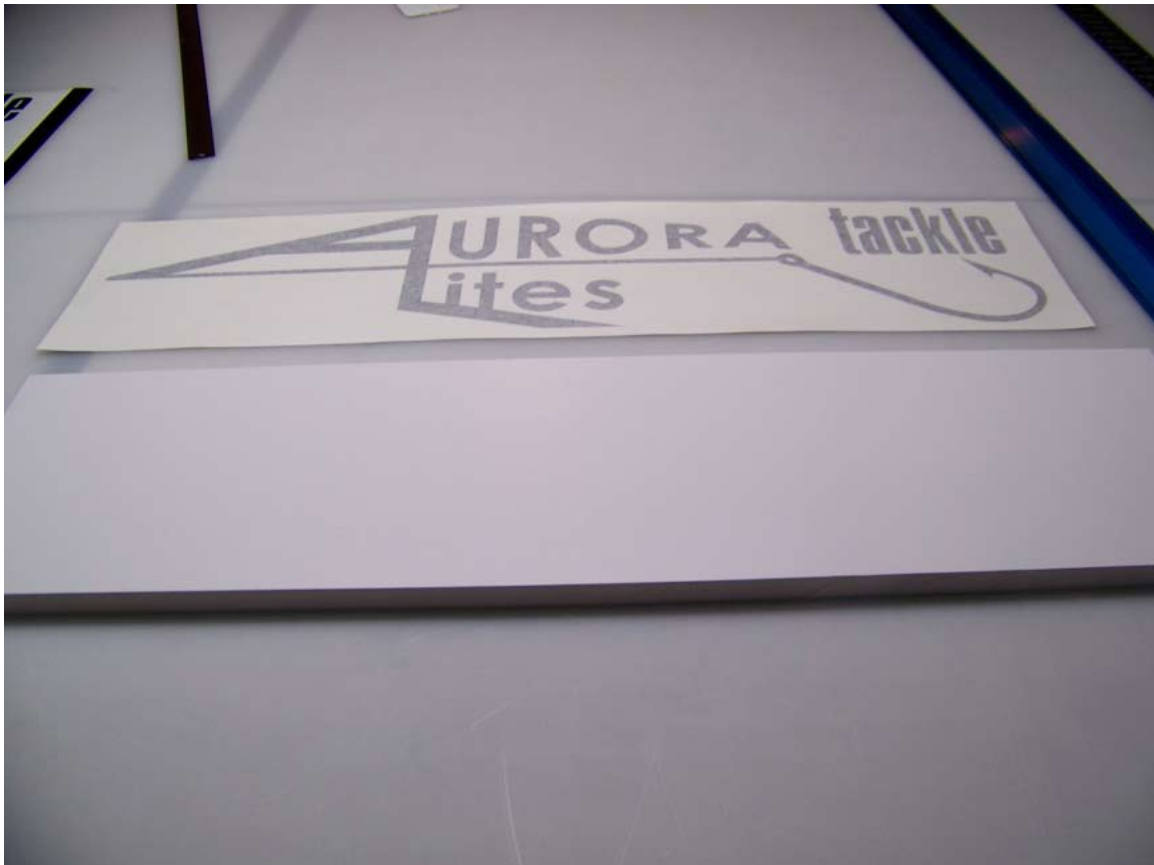


Vinyl Decal Application Instructions



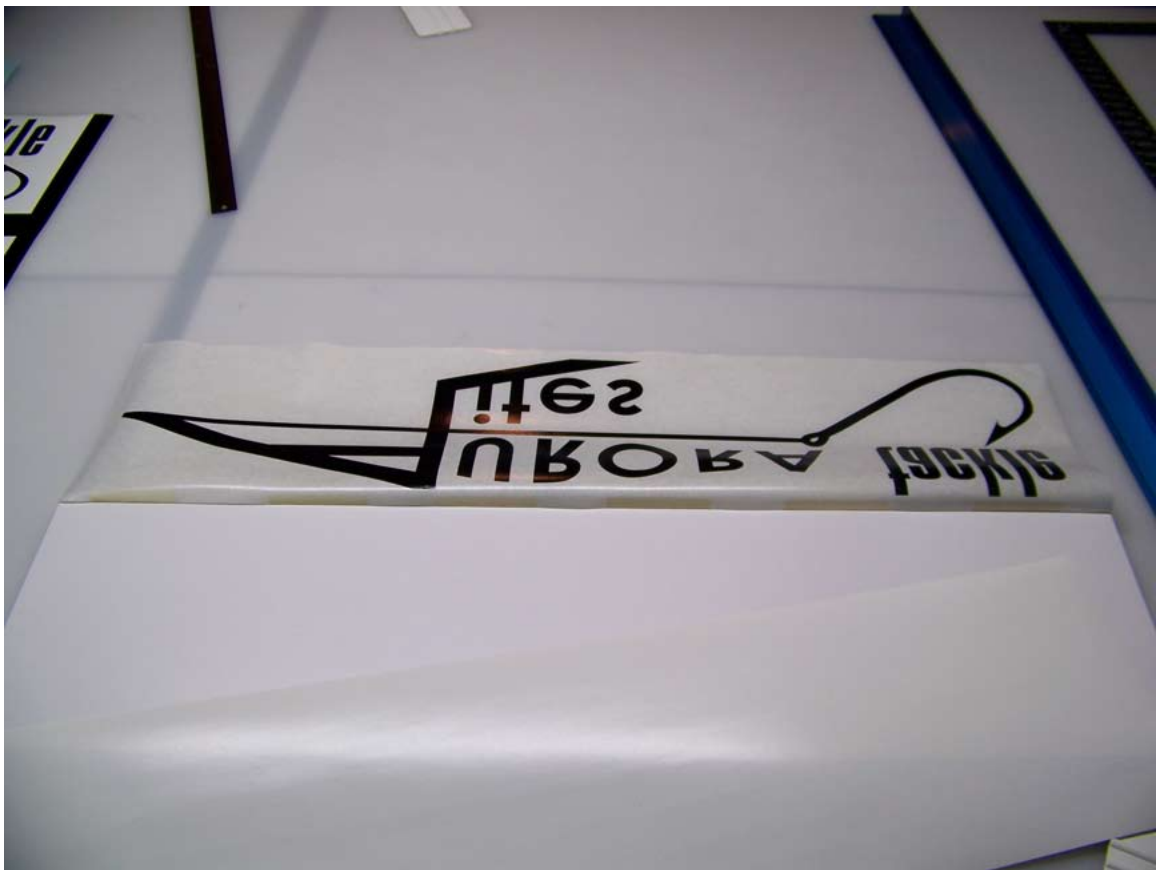
1.) When you receive your vinyl decal lay it out on a flat surface and apply pressure to the vinyl areas so the application tape is stuck to it very good. Use a squeegee, roller, or your fingers.



2.) Clean the surface that the decal is being applied to with denatured alcohol to remove any dirt or oil (denatured alcohol is available at any hardware store).



3.) Place decal on surface it's being applied to and tape it in place with masking tape.



4.) Very carefully pull back the top application tape off of the backing. Make sure while pulling application tape back that all the vinyl is stuck to it! If it's not try pushing the tape back onto the vinyl.. Now that you have the vinyl stuck onto the application tape remove the backing sheet. Then start applying your decal from the (masking tape) top down keeping it smooth as you work your way down the decal. Once you have the decal applied to the surface apply pressure to the vinyl areas again with a roller, squeegee, or your fingers to make sure it's stuck very good to the surface.



5.) Now that you have the decal stuck to the surface, very carefully pull off the application tape.



6.) Almost done, the last step you want to perform after pulling off the application tape is to push down the vinyl one last time with a roller, or your fingers to make sure it's stuck to the surface. If the decals are installed correctly they will last for years. They are very easy to remove too, just peel them off.
